Qualifications

As Special Deputy US Marshal charged with investigation of Homeland Security matters involving potential terrorist misuse of hazardous materials, Mr. Lai was responsible for numerous convictions and fines levied against individuals as well as large corporations. Most of these convictions were direct result of computer forensic work in preparation for trial. Computer forensic assignments ranged from individual computers to mobile media to large scale servers.

Mr. Lai was trained to fly armed onboard commercial airlines in the event of criminal or terrorist activities in the skies as a matter of course of duties for a Special Deputy USM. He possesses a California Department of Justice certificate for Diginitary Security and Protection Course and has executed wide array of protective missions for visiting dignitaries. He is a member of the International Association of Law Enforcement Firearms Instructors (IALEFI) and the American Society current member of Law Enforcement Training (ASLET).

As a licensed private investigator, Mr. Lai has worked numerous civil and criminal cases ranging from private executive protection investigative work to field surveillance and evidence collection. Military Service

Having served our country in the US Navy during the first Gulf War, he earned a National Defense Medal for service with VFA-305, an F/A-18 Strike Fighter Squadron aboard the aircraft carrier USS Nimitz (CVN-68). He is also the recipient of the Expert Pistol Marksman Medal and the coveted Battle "E" Ribbon for unit combat efficiency. He served aboard the aircraft carrier USS Enterprise (CVN-65) as part of VFA-303, the first reserve squadron to receive the new F/A-18 fighter attack aircraft at the time when they transitioned from the old A7 Corsair. Besides advanced naval aviation, SGT Lai also has experience in military police matters with enforcement responsibilities under the Uniform Code of Military Justice (UCMJ), the military's principle laws.
